Drone drops dummy bomb; soldier killed

RHOPAL: An army jawan was killed during a training exercise at the Sukna Sewaanya range in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh when a dummy bomb dropped from a drone hit his head, police said on Tuesday.

The incident took place on Monday when the victim, identified as jawan Vijay Singh from Uttaranchal, was struck by the dummy bomb, which weighed four kilograms and was dropped from a drone at a designated range, but it was dropped suddenly on the head of Singh, Bhopal SP Pramod said.

The SP said that the victim's body has been sent for post-mortem examination, adding that a probe has been launched to find out if the incident was caused by a technical fault or due to non-compliance with safety norms.

"The incident occurred during a training session where soldiers were being taught to drop bombs on targets and detect them themselves. An iron dummy bomb was placed in a drone flying over the range, intended to drop at a designated range, but it was dropped suddenly on the head of Singh," Bhopal SP Pramod said.

The SP said that the victim's body has been sent for post-mortem examination, adding that a probe has been launched to find out if the incident was caused by a technical fault or due to non-compliance with safety norms.

2 men from Haryana killed in US accident

KARMAI: Two men from Haryana died in a road accident in the United States, one of the victims said on Tuesday.

The incident took place in the US state of California on Monday when the two victims, identified as Vishal Kumar (21) from Karnal and Arun Jangra alias Romi (24) Kathial, were reportedly travelling in a car that hit a truck. Families of the victims said that they were informed about the accident on Tuesday morning.

IIM-M launches new incubation centre

MUMBAI: The Indian Institute of Management (IIM)-Mumbai on Tuesday inaugurated a new innovation centre to encourage innovation and support aspiring entrepreneurs. The centre, called the IIM-NITIE Incubation Foundation for Innovation and Entrepreneurship (IIM-NIEF), was inaugurated by Union MoS Dr Jayanta Singh. The centre falls under the Atmanirvan Mission and aims to assist innovators and startups.

Trump suggested the converse would allow Iranian oil to continue to flow, saying on social media that China could keep purchasing crude from Iran.

The deal got off to a rocky start as Iran faced off with the US over a proposal to amend its oil export laws to bring its oil in line with international regulations and ban exports two miles at Israel's ports into the region to ease both were unaccepted, the official said.

Iranian state television reported that the military denied firing missiles after the start of the ceasefire while conducting missile strikes on its own. One of those attacks killed a high-profile nuclear scientist, Ali Akbar Salehi, son of its former president, in northern Iran, state TV reported.

Trump spoke to reporters at the White House before departing for the NATO summit, he expressed disappointment with both sides that Iran violated it but Israel violated it, "Trump said. "I'm not happy with Israel."

Trump's illustration was perhaps using an aptive to hammer home his point. "We basically have two countries that are so far apart geographically so hard that they don't know what the f*** they're doing," he said.

Later, however, he announced that Israel had backed off its threat to attack Tehran and would turn its jets around.

Netanyahu's office said Israel struck in Iranian radar space in response to the Iranian missile attack early Tuesday, but Israel forces held off launching big strikes for nearly 20 minutes and instead focused on smaller strikes to prevent collateral risks.

Netanyahu's office said Israel had agreed to a truce in coordination with Trump after the country achieved all of its war goals, including removing the threat of Iran's nuclear and ballistic missile programs.

It's unclear what role Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, Iran's leader, played in the talks. He said earlier this month that he would not compromise on his country's nuclear and ballistic missile programs.

Trump said Tuesday that he wasn't seeking regime change in Iran, two days after frostying the idea himself in a social media post.

"I don't want it," Trump told reporters on Air Force One. "Regime change takes chaos and, ideally, we don't want to see much chaos."

Before the ceasefire was announced, Israeli military said it had targeted 20 Iranian missiles and 100 vehicles toward Israel. Police said they damaged at least three densely packed residential buildings in the city of Beersheba. First responders said they retrieved four bodies from one building and were searching for more. At least 20 people were injured.

Outside, the shells of burned out tanks littered the streets. Blown-up glass and rubble covered the areas. Police said some people were injured while inside their homes, including several bathrooms, which are meant to withstand rockets but did not protect them from ballistic missiles.

The strike followed a limited Iranian missile attack Monday on US military bases in Qatar, retaliating for earlier American bombing of its nuclear sites. The US, was warned by Iran in advance, and there were no casualties. Drones attacked military bases in Iraq overnight, including those housing US troops, the Iraqi army and a US anti-Isis coalition.

A senior US military official, who spoke on condition of anonymity because he was not authorized to comment publicly, said US forces shot down drones attacking Ain al-Asad in the desert in western Iraq and at a base next to the Baghdad airport, while another one crashed.

No fatalities were reported, and no group claimed responsibility for the attack. In Iraq, Iranian-backed militia groups had previously threatened to target US bases if the US attacked Iran. In Israel, at least 26 people were killed in the war. Israeli strikes on Iran have killed at least 974 people and wounded 3,658 others, according to the Washington-based group Human Rights Activists.
